

Neches ISD Parent Notification System

Dear Parent,

The Neches ISD School District uses the SchoolMessenger notification service to send important information to families through phone calls and text messages.

To comply with wireless carrier requirements and protect you against unsolicited text messages, you may receive, or may already have received, an SMS message to the wireless cell phone number that the district has on file, requesting that you opt in to receive important information from the district via SMS text message.

The message you receive will be or was similar to the following:

"Neches ISD alerts. Reply Y for aprx 5 msgs/mo. Txt HELP 4 info. Msg&data rates may apply. Visit schoolmessenger.com/tm"

So that you can continue to receive these important messages from Neches ISD, we encourage you to reply with "Y" or "Yes" or "OPTIN" when you receive such a verification message.

To opt out of all text messages from SchoolMessenger, visit <http://www.schoolmessenger.com/txtmsg/> or reply with STOP to the opt-in message that you receive. If you opt in, but decide to opt out later on, you may also reply "STOP" to any message or send "STOP" to 68453.

If you are not sure whether or not you received and responded to our invitation, you can text "Y", "YES", "OPTIN" or "OPT IN" to 68453. If you have already received text messages from the school, this will not be necessary.

Phone messages, text messages, television, and radio are the **ONLY** methods by which Neches ISD will broadcast school closure or school delays. *Neches ISD does NOT utilize Facebook, Twiter or any other social media to broadcast these messages or notify parents.*

The school district does not pay for text message charges that may be incurred by you for sending or receiving text messages. Check with your wireless carrier for possible charges.
